The Municipality of Grassland is currently accepting applications for the position of Municipal Equipment Operator / Public Works Labourer. This full-time, permanent position, based out of the Municipality's Fairfax Shop location, plays a key role in the maintenance and upkeep of the Municipality's extensive gravel road network, along with other general public works responsibilities.

Key Responsibilities

- **Gravel Road Maintenance:** Perform seasonal maintenance of municipal gravel roads including plowing, grading, shaping, and drainage improvements.
- **Equipment Operation:** Operate and maintain various types of heavy equipment such as graders, loaders, tractors and other municipal machinery in a safe and efficient manner.
- **Routine Inspections and Maintenance:** Conduct daily inspections of equipment and tools, perform basic maintenance, and report mechanical issues to the foreman.
- Demonstrate continuous efforts to improve operations, work cooperatively with council and ratepayers
- Work collaboratively with other public works staff on various infrastructure projects and respond to direction from the Public Works Foreman.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license.
- After hours response as necessary.
- Other duties as assigned.

Additional Duties May Include:

- Assist with general public works tasks including road repairs, culvert installations, signage maintenance, snow and ice control efforts.
- Support additional maintenance activities, such as landscaping, facility upkeep and assistance during emergency response situations.

The Municipality of Grassland offers a pension plan and benefits package. Salary is negotiable depending on experience and qualifications.
